on mission TEAM TRAINING DAY
 JUNE 2018

Good morning to you all. A couple of cool things to consider this morning:

First, thanks to all those who attended the diocesan leaders training day in Palmerston

North last Saturday. Once upon a time, not so long ago, these were dry events that few wanted to attend and resembled the last gasps of a dying organisation. Last week over 300 people attended various seminars on church leadership, management and mission workshops. It's open to all who would like to attend, and there will be another training day at Samuel Marsden Collegiate School in Karori, Wellington, on the 8th of September. Put it in your diary to attend.

Second, money. I am starting to think about 2019 and the future of our parish ministry. The planning team has been working hard in the background to consider our long-term ministry and mission direction, but there are many already existing ministry issues that we need to address. The obvious ones are Christian education, prayer, home groups, international missions, and broad youth and young adult ministry in the local community. None of this is new, however, as these areas always need revisiting. Nevertheless, the most substantial need of all is our buildings which are in significant need of refurbishment and development for the future of the church. For too many years we have been balancing the budget by reducing expenditure (mostly on maintenance and staffing), which essentially means we are declining by stealth. That can't continue. So, in August of this year, we will be running a stewardship month. It aims to encourage people to consider the following: giving more regularly, increasing their giving, move to electronic banking, give systematically for the first time, and, on top of that, perhaps commit to funding specific small projects along the way. I will start to unfold what we are hoping to achieve in the coming year, and how it will require a reasonable increase from our current financial status.

There is only one direction for the future: growth; it's very challenging and consequently exciting.
