Building Refurbishment update.

A few weeks back we let you know that the Vestry has begun exploring what can be done to refurbish our St Christopher's facilities, a task that has needed to happen for some time. John McClean from BSM architects has begun working on a revised floor plan of the main church, annex and hall, alongside current building code requirements and rules. Once this is completed the Vestry will call for a church meeting to look at the plans and the options before us to determine a way forward. Currently we have raised \$18,500 of the \$21,000 needed for this first stage. If you can help financially to get the project underway it would be appreciated.
