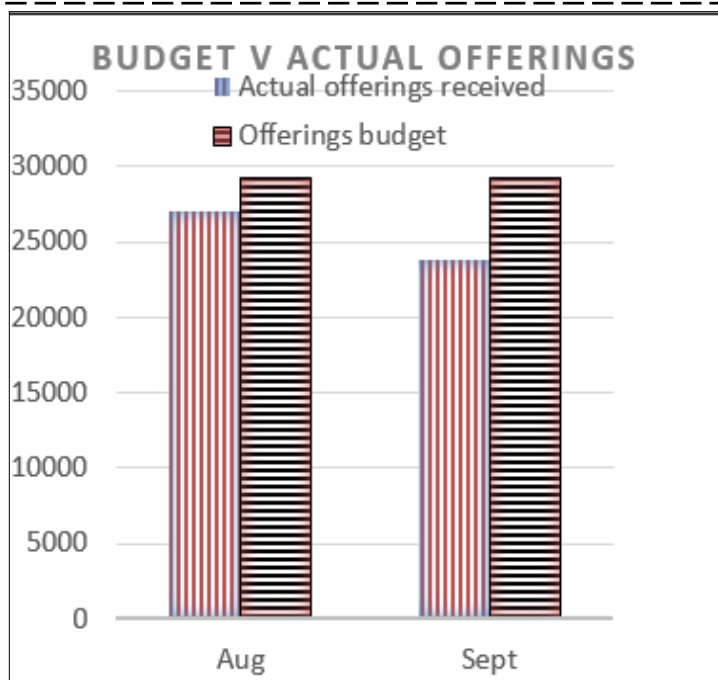
The ministry of the church operates on the generosity and commitment of our church community. We invite you to give on a regular basis by one of the following methods:
