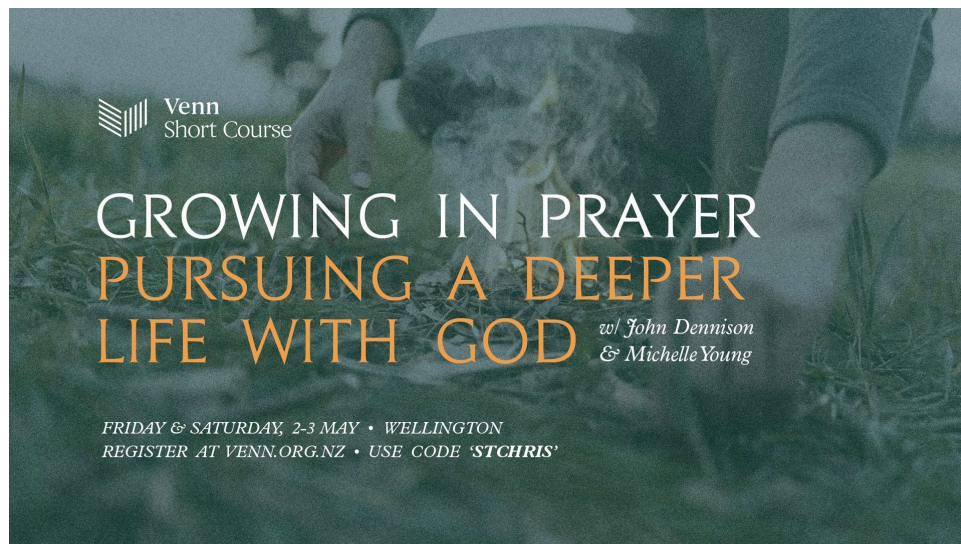

Prayer Chain

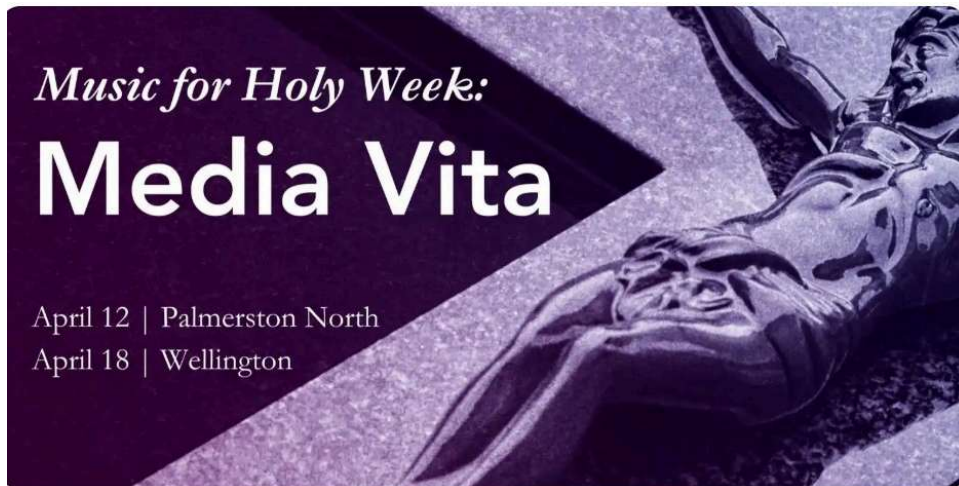

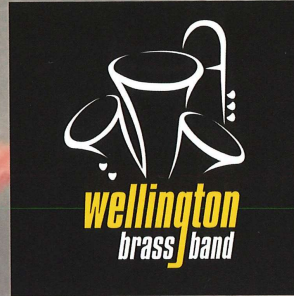
